
















ASPECTS OF ACCESSIBLE WORSHIP - REFLECTIVE ASSESSMENT

Dimension	Brief Description	What Did You Notice?
Architecture 	The physical features and layout of a church, as well as the ease with which the sanctuary can be navigated	
Attitudes 	Views regarding disability that are expressed in words or actions	
Communication 	The ways in which information is imparted or exchanged throughout worship services	
Contributions 	Opportunities to share one's gifts or serve others within the context of regular worship services	
Expectations 	Unspoken assumptions or rules regarding which behaviors are expected, encouraged, or allowed	

ASPECTS OF ACCESSIBLE WORSHIP - REFLECTIVE ASSESSMENT

Dimension	Brief Description	What Did You Notice?
<p>Interactions</p> 	<p>The social exchanges and conversations that take place before, during, and after worship services</p>	
<p>Liturgy</p> 	<p>The structure, sequence, activities, and predictability of worship services</p>	
<p>Postures</p> 	<p>The overall stance regarding flexibility and adaptability within worship services</p>	
<p>Sense of Community</p> 	<p>Having deep affiliation, friendships, and/or belonging within one's faith community</p>	
<p>Sensory Factors</p> 	<p>Volume, lighting, textural or tactile input, temperature, and other sensory elements that impact participation</p>	

ASPECTS OF ACCESSIBLE WORSHIP - REFLECTIVE ASSESSMENT

Dimension	Brief Description	What Did You Notice?
<p>Supports</p> 	<p>Individualized assistance that enables full and meaningful participation in worship services</p>	
<p>Technology</p> 	<p>The array of tools, devices, and apps that can enable or enhance participation</p>	
<p>Theology</p> 	<p>Religious beliefs related to disability or statements about how God views disability or disabled people</p>	
<p>Transportation</p> 	<p>The extent to which people have a reliable way of getting to and from worship services</p>	
<p>Understanding</p> 	<p>The extent to which preaching, readings, and other information are shared in clear and understandable ways</p>
